

The Australian Immunisation Register (AIR)

How to correctly identify an individual on the AIR

When you give a vaccine, record it on the AIR!
It's important to make sure you correctly identify an individual so their immunisation history is up to date.

Individual is enrolled with Medicare

Use your patient's Medicare card, Individual Reference Number (IRN), full name and date of birth to identify them on the AIR.



To confirm or search a patient's Medicare details, you can:

use **Identify Individual** on the AIR site.



use **Find a Patient using Health Professional Online Services (HPOS)**.



use **Online Patient Verification** in your *PMS.



Individual isn't enrolled with Medicare

Individual's who aren't enrolled in Medicare may already have an AIR record.

Search the AIR thoroughly using the details provided.
Confirming personal information using a form of identification may assist.
If there isn't a match on the AIR you can create a new record.
