

# Relative Value Guide for anaesthesia order of services billing



You must submit anaesthetic items in a specific order or your claim will be rejected.

The table below lists the order to bill the items in:

Order	Anaesthetic items
1. Base unit value	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 20100-21997 or 22900-22905 if you're the anaesthetist</li><li>• 25200 and 25205 if you're the assistant anaesthetist</li><li>• 22060 if you're the perfusionist</li></ul>
2. Time unit value	23010-24136
3. Physical status modifier	25000-25010
4. Age modifier	25015
5. Emergency modifier (in hours)	25020
6. Therapeutic and diagnostic services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 22002-22051 if you're the anaesthetist, the assistant anaesthetist or the perfusionist</li><li>• 22055 or 22065-22075 if you're the perfusionist</li></ul>
7. Emergency modifier (after hours)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 25025 if you're the anaesthetist</li><li>• 25030 if you're the assistant anaesthetist</li><li>• 25050 if you're the perfusionist</li></ul>
